Any person can be a Councillor if they are not be disqualified under legislation from standing as a Councillor and meet one of the following:

- the applicant's name appears on the current Register of Electors for the Parish.
- the applicant has during the whole of the twelve months preceding the relevant date occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the Parish.
- the applicant's only place of work during the whole of the twelve months preceding the relevant date is within the Parish.
- the applicant has during the whole of the last 12 months resided in that Parish or within 4.8 kilometres of it.
